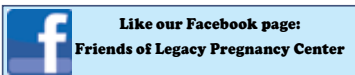

# 2022 Gala Report: Breathe - In and Out His Name, Jesus

This year's theme is Breathe—In and Out His name, Jesus.



When I first learned of the theme "Breathe", I didn't know the second part of "In and Out His name, Jesus". I always ask God to give me a word or phrase when I speak or for when I emcee. A word

or phrase to begin the evening with and to help set the stage. He kept saying "Just breathe my name." So often when my life gets overwhelming (and it has a lot the last couple years) and I feel paralyzed, the only thing I can do is stop....., breathe....., and say Jesus.

As always God is good and it is a small detail but a fun confirmation of His hand on this evening and this ministry when I found out that what He was speaking to me was also the theme the Legacy staff and leadership had come up with. I love when God does that.

When sharing this little story with a friend recently, she told me of a devotion she'd heard on the radio of the meaning of Yahweh. The original word in Hebrew was actually to be breathed in and out. Yah inhaled, Weh exhaled. His special name was not to be spoken by the Jews, but only as syllables breathed in and out. Quite literally His name is on our every breath.

"Let everything that has breath praise" Psalm 150:6. Those who don't believe in Him will say His name on their breath even to their last dying breath. But for those of us who do believe, we can praise Him with our every breath.

But often when life gets busy or hard or overwhelming or chaotic and we forget to praise Him. Though we are breathing, a life giving natural thing we humans do; breathing automatically and subconsciously, it is when we stop for a moment and purposely breathe in His spirit and Breathe out His name Jesus that we enter in and acknowledge our dependence on Him. Tonight we take pause from our lives and ask that we all just breathe a bit more purposefully tonight. Breathe In and Out His name Jesus as we come together as brothers and sisters in Christ and praise Him for His work and hand in this ministry.

# Welcome, Kendra Rono!

*Kendra is our new Client Service / Nurse Sonographer*



My husband and I came to Sheridan in June 2020 after COVID had closed down our kids school and daycare in Cheyenne. We had been working at the hospital there. We are both nurses and I worked in the ER my husband on Ortho/Neuro floor. My kids came to Sheridan for their usual spring break vacation to visit Grandpa and Grandma and ended up not

returning home. My parents finished the school year from home with them while my husband worked the COVID floor and I worked the high-risk area of the ER. We came to the conclusion that it was safer for them isolated in Sheridan until we knew more about COVID. After about 4 weeks of separation, it began to take a toll on us, and we sold our house and bought a camper and made the big move to Sheridan. The day before we moved into our home in October, the camper froze up in that first big snowstorm. Ironically we never dreamed of moving North, we always said if we ever sold our home in Cheyenne we would move South where it was warm, you see neither of us like the cold. But it is funny how God works and puts you in the place that you are meant to be even if you can't see it at the time. We have since added another baby to the mix. So the total count is 3 kids and 2 adults, we are officially out numbered. We have Grace who is 9, Elizabeth who is 6, and Elijah who is 2 years old.

We attend Bethesda Worship Center and it has become a second home for us there. I am told that it is one of the larger churches in town, but it sure doesn't feel that way. It has been a safe haven, and everyone has become like family. I never dreamed of living up North, but I am glad that God placed us here because we are putting down roots and falling in love with this community more and more every day.

When we are not working, we like to go to the mountains and enjoy hiking and exploring with the kids. One of our favorite things to do is to find new waterfalls to hike to. We like to take weekend getaways around Wyoming and into South Dakota. I also enjoy just staying home, reading books and tinkering in the garden outside. We like to take walks down to the park and wade around in the creek in the summer. There is just so much endless fun around here. My husband and I have been married for 10 years. We met working night shift as CNAs at a nursing home in Cheyenne. He is originally from a small remote village in Nandi County Kenya. We have had the privilege of visiting his family there twice now. It was a humbling experience to go there and see the local medical clinic and work along side some of the nurses. It further grew my desire to do more mission work. I went to nursing school to do medical missions but when we had our first child that shifted to serving locally.

When I found out about Legacy and the open job, I just knew right away that this was where I was meant to be. I prayed a lot about it and even typed up a resume, but I "chickened out" and did not submit it for another month. When I finally did, I thought the job had been posted too long and I was sure that it was filled already. To my amazement I got an interview and landed my dream job! I have always had a dream to work within perinatal but have never had the opportunity to do so. To be able to serve at Legacy and my little community is a dream come true. It is a daily reminder that waiting on God to move and work is always worth it.

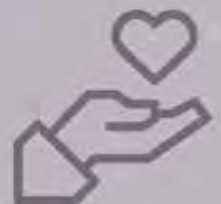
