Finding Help to Choose Life!

When you give to Legacy, you are offering help to men and women just like Ralynn and Michael. Thank you!

Ralynn and Michael came to Legacy after seeing on our website that we serve individuals and families who are facing unexpected pregnancies. The couple had not performed a pregnancy test but Ralynn felt confident that she was in fact pregnant. While the couple had initially considered abortion, they had decided to parent due to the fact that both had histories of abortions in previous relationships. Michael expressed that his abortion with his former girlfriend had caused that relationship to deteriorate. For Ralynn, her abortion was something she had felt was necessary due to lack of support at the time; however, she stated that it had been a physically and emotionally difficult experience that she was still struggling to deal with.

At Legacy, Ralynn was able to have a medical grade pregnancy test which came back positive. She and Michael were able to meet with a caring advocate who helped them explore their hopes and fears regarding the pregnancy and becoming parents. Local community supports and resources were reviewed, including counseling, financial supports, local churches and the remote Earn While You Learn curriculum (Brightcourse). Ralynn then met with the nurse and completed testing for Gonorrhea, Chlamydia and HIV. The visit concluded with an ultrasound which revealed a very active 12 week old baby. The couple left expressing to staff that they felt more hopeful than when they had arrived.

Ralynn returned for a follow-up visit one week later to review STI results. Ralynn came by herself to this appointment and she was also able to meet with an abortion recovery mentor in the office to start to process her abortion experience. This initial meeting established a relationship which led to their meeting on a weekly basis to go through the 'Surrendering the Secret' study on recovering from abortion. Over the course of the next several months, both Ralynn and Michael participated in completing Brightcourse lessons about pregnancy, labor and delivery, newborn care and fatherhood. By completing this program they earned the newborn photography session donated by a local photographer and a brand new car seat that several months later held their newborn son.

Brightcourse Online Learning via Legacy

Brightcourse is an on-line extension of the "Earn While You Learn" curriculum in which clients can gain valuable information while earning necessary items for baby. Clients can participate via their phones or receive lessons via email. There are over 50 lessons offered which include topics such as prenatal development, what to expect when pregnant, labor and delivery and how to care for a newborn. In addition to these helpful classes, there are now new topics offered such as fatherhood, life skills, healthy relationships and a Bible study pack! Clients earn an amazing newborn photography session with Emily Robin Photography halfway through the curriculum and a brand new car seat upon completion. They can spend baby bucks in our Baby Boutique for items such as clothes, diapers, baby swings and blankets. We are happy that through Brightcourse we can tailor the curriculum for both our moms and dads that are expecting and we are seeing an increase in participating fathers as a result!

2021 Walk Volunteer Opportunities



Walk Chair: Do you have excellent leadership and organizational skills? The Walk Chair is responsible to see that the tasks for the Walk are completed and work closely with the Walk Team. Recruits and trains phone workers, delivery workers, and a walk site captain. Involves a weekly commitment of 4-8 hours.

Walk for Life Church Liaisons: Church liaisons are a very crucial part of the Walk staffing. Liaisons

effectively communicate with their church bodies, ensure that announcements and signage are in place, and help their church enthusiastically partner to make the Walk successful. They pick up and deliver walk materials and may meet with their pastor to share their vision for the Walk.

Church Liaison Coordinator: Are you excited about being your church's liaison? Help pass on your passion and mentor other liaisons in creating effective Walk presentations. Liaison captains encourage other liaisons and maintain weekly contact, seeing that they have all the materials they need for their church and that announcements are made.

Walk Prayer Coordinator: A mature Christian who loves to pray and likes to get others involved as well. Keeps in close contact with the Walk Chair for updates on prayer needs and answered prayers and recruits others in praying for the Walk and its participants. Organizes a system for passing on prayer requests and answered prayer.

Telephone Workers: Contact churches and individuals to ask them to participate in the walk, especially previous walkers and volunteers.

Registration & Booth Volunteers: Help register walkers, distribute/sell t-shirts, and set out food & drinks. Setup & clean up on the day of the Walk.
