Emma and Bryan

Your gifts allow us to provide the counselling, support and classes that Emma and Bryan needed to choose life!

Emma and her boyfriend, Bryan, came to Legacy together after Emma started to suspect she might be pregnant. The two had only been dating for several months and Bryan was under the impression that he was unable to have children due to an injury years ago. It was, therefore, with trepidation that they looked at the positive pregnancy test performed by Legacy's nurse at their first appointment. On the one hand, Bryan felt excitement and anticipation at being able to be a father. On the other hand, neither of them were prepared to commit to staying together to raise a baby. Emma confirmed that their relationship had had its challenges and while they cared about each other, they weren't sure what the future might hold for them.

Through options mentoring, Legacy staff helped the couple to pause and consider the things that really mattered to each of them. Neither Emma or Bryan felt like abortion or adoption would be choices that they would feel good about in the future. Bryan stated that while he wouldn't have to "worry about coparenting" if he and Emma didn't stay together, he thought that choosing abortion would "eat me alive" later on. Both Emma and Bryan felt a bit of excitement, though, about the knowledge that there was a new life to be considered. This excitement was amplified when they saw

the heartbeat on the screen of the ultrasound. Emma expressed anticipation at the thought of having "a mini-me!" to take care of and to make "life more meaningful."

In that initial appointment Emma and Bryan were able to learn about the supports available for them from Legacy and the community if they chose to parent their baby. The nurse reviewed prenatal care and resources such as WIC and Medicaid. They were especially interested in our EWYL classes that provided education about what to expect in each trimester, labor and delivery and how to take care of a newborn. Bryan had not had a positive father figure in his life and he expressed wanting to do a better job at being a dad than what he had experienced. Over the weeks and months that followed Bryan finished the entire EWYL course that was geared towards fatherhood. Legacy staff was impressed by his commitment

to be the best dad he could be even before baby was born. Likewise, Emma was very engaged at coming in for her appointments and participating in events like the Christmas Hope List.

Eventually their baby girl was born and was indeed the “mini me” that Emma had hoped for. Emma and Bryan sought counseling for relationship issues but eventually broke up. Legacy staff offered them help with a coparenting curriculum that is available at Legacy to assist parents raising children between two households. Emma and Bryan are learning to work together to create the best relationship they can so that their baby knows that they both are committed to her health and well-being in the future. “We need more people like you in this world,” commented Emma regarding her experience at Legacy.

Abortion ≠ Hope...

As many of you may already know, a full-service abortion provider is slated to open in Casper, Wyoming. According to people in the area, this may occur on June 1st. The non-profit responsible for organizing its operation is called Circle of Hope and there are pictures of its 2nd Street facility on its website. According to its website*, Casper has specifically been chosen by this small non-profit because it is in an “abortion desert” and expects to provide abortion services to women living in Wyoming, as well as western South Dakota and Nebraska who don’t have close surgical abortion facilities. (Medication abortions have been available in Wyoming through 10 weeks of pregnancy for several years and are now available via mail. Surgical abortion options are important to abortion advocates because some women don’t find out they are pregnant until after 10 weeks.)



Women and girls living in Sheridan & Johnson County pursuing abortion will most likely still go to Planned Parenthood in Billings as it is closer. We don’t necessarily expect abortion numbers in our immediate locality to increase due to another provider that is also two hours away. However, in Casper and its nearby towns, as well as Gillette, Rawlins, Rapid City, and Chadron, this facility IS closer than Billings or Ft. Collins and, although rural, could have a more open schedule than these busier clinics. Depending on availability of appointments, a woman could find out that she was pregnant and drive to her appointment on the same day, leaving her to only engage her fear, and not her options, faith or support system. We could expect an organization whose aim is to make abortion more accessible to offer more hours or days than traditional, corporate models. We simply do not know how it might impact Legacy’s clients.

We don’t share this with you because we are worried and encourage you as well to not become titillated or overwhelmed with this information. The world is full of reactive outrage, and it probably exhausts us more than animates us toward any true good. We do invite you to pray specifically for:

- the founders, funders, and employees of this abortion organization.
- light and life to overwhelm darkness and death.
- the staff, volunteers, and supporters of True Care (Casper Pregnancy Center);
- any client seeking an abortion to find hope at a supportive church and/or pregnancy center.
- clients seeking a pregnancy center’s help to not be misled by the misnomer “Circle of Hope”;
- God’s manifest presence in all the details of this situation.

May we participate in the sufferings of Christ by absorbing the world’s sin, chaos, violence, and tension and only returning grace, love, peace, and joy, made possible by the constant intercession, and strengthening of the Holy Spirit on our behalf.

*We are intentionally not including the clinic’s website at this time because that will enhance its position in internet searches, making it easier to find.



Safe Haven Baby Box

A Baby Box is a safety device that is provided for under the Safe Haven Law and legally permits a mother in crisis to safely, securely, and anonymously surrender her baby if she is unable to care for her newborn. Sheridan Memorial Hospital's proposed Baby Box will be installed in an exterior wall. It has an exterior door that automatically locks upon placement of a newborn inside the Baby Box, and an interior door which allows a medical staff member to secure the surrendered newborn from inside the designated building.

If approved by the hospital's board, Legacy Pregnancy Center will purchase this \$15,000 safety device. If you would like to give toward this life-saving initiative, please note Safe Haven on your check's memo or on the online donation drop-down menu.
