## From Uncertain to Grateful

Marcy and Brian came to Legacy Pregnancy Center through a community referral after discovering they were expecting. Like many couples, they entered their first appointment with uncertainty, but the ultrasound confirming life in the womb became a pivotal moment in their decision to parent. From that point forward, they committed fully, engaging in pregnancy courses, childbirth classes, and earning essential baby items through the Baby Boutique, while also building meaningful connection in the mommy group.

As they completed the Earn While You Learn program, they celebrated receiving a new convertible car seat and are now continuing into parenting courses. With the demands of work and preparing for their baby, they are taking advantage of BrightCourse online classes, allowing them to keep learning and earning incentives that can be shipped directly to their home.

What stood out most to them was not just the practical support, but the environment, everything offered freely, with no strings attached. In a small town where privacy matters, they appreciated the ability to park discreetly outside the center, and more importantly, the peace they experienced. Though they initially felt nervous about their decision, they encountered no judgment—only support as they thoughtfully processed their options.

Today, Marcy and Brian are not only preparing for the birth of their child but are continuing to grow as parents and individuals. They remain deeply grateful for the ongoing programs that extend beyond pregnancy, equipping them to parent well, strengthen their life skills, and deepen their relationship with God.

## Restoration

This year’s Legacy Gala is centered on a powerful truth:

**God meets people in the wilderness—and restoration begins there.**

For many women facing an unexpected pregnancy, life can feel like unfamiliar terrain, uncertain, overwhelming, and often isolating. It is in those moments that Legacy exists to meet them, not with pressure, but with compassion. Not with answers forced upon them, but with support that helps them take the next step forward.

Psalm 23 reminds us that even in the wilderness, we are not abandoned. God leads, provides, and restores. Legacy lives out that calling by walking alongside women and families with **emotional, practical, educational, and spiritual support**, helping them move from crisis toward clarity and hope.

This evening is designed to reflect that journey, from uncertainty to refuge, from fear to restoration.

The Gala is more than a gathering. It is a shared purpose. It is a moment to come together as a community and reaffirm something deeply important:

That no woman should have to navigate a difficult pregnancy alone. No father should feel excluded, and no families alone. That support matters. That presence matters. And when someone feels lost in the wilderness, having a place to turn can change everything. Because when God finds someone in the wilderness, He often does it through people willing to show up.

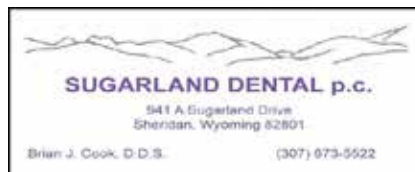

While our ongoing work is sustained through regular giving, the endowment serves as a protective foundation—providing peace of mind that the mission can endure through difficult seasons, should they ever arise.

## **Why do people choose to give to the endowment?**
